

## Ministering at “Youth in Action Conference” in Ternopil

Margarita and I had a blessed time of ministering to 99 young people who came for “Youth in Action Conference” from several different regions of Ukraine from July 8 to 12. During the conference, we also counseled over 60 young people individually. Many of these young people came from broken, rejected, wounded and dysfunctional homes without fathers. Their broken hearts and wounded souls had to be healed and delivered from many psychological abuses that they endured during their childhood. Through the counseling sessions, Margarita and I were able to identify the root causes of their sufferings and delivered them from their severe bondages of the past. When the power of the Holy Spirit touched them, they were able to forgive those people who had hurt them in the past. As they forgave them, God’s mighty healing power came down upon them and set them free from all kinds of bondages in their lives. It was our great joy to witness the transformation of these precious young people. We also ministered at “Ethnos Church” which hosts “Youth in Action Conference” on July 7th. and Ethnos Drug Rehabilitation Center on July 18th.

Evnika (far left) witnessed to Tanya and brought her to the Youth in Action Conference. Tanya witnessed her father who committed suicide by hanging in her own home when she was five years old. Her mother abandoned her to an orphanage where she had been badly abused. Eventually, she was adopted to a family but she was also abused by her adopted mother. Her birth mother was murdered by her living boyfriend later. She left her adopted home when she was 18 years old and she had to survive in the street. Eventually, she met Evnika at work and she committed her life to Christ at the Conference. During the counseling session with Tanya, the Holy Spirit touched and healed her from her past abuses, guilt and shame and baptized her with His love and power. When she finally got up after being under the glory of God for more than 40 minutes, her countenance was totally changed and she knew that she was totally delivered from the bondages of the devil. During the camp fire on the last night of the camp, she testified of God's victory in her life for 30 minutes.



Roxolana shared with Margarita and me about her past wounds, hurts and sufferings. Due to her past abuses, she would have panic attacks when she was with a group of people. She felt that no one really loved or cared for her. After we led her to forgive all those people who had hurt her in the past, she was able to receive God's divine deliverance through the power of the Holy Spirit. After her deliverance, she testified during the morning session and she didn't have any more panic attacks with her assigned group at the camp. John 8:36 was fulfilled in her life, "So if the Son sets you free, you will be free indeed."

During the Sunday morning service 20 drug addicts in the program gave their lives to Christ and several people were totally healed of different kinds of physical sicknesses. Olga was totally healed of her back pain for four years.
