



Have a blessed Thanksgiving

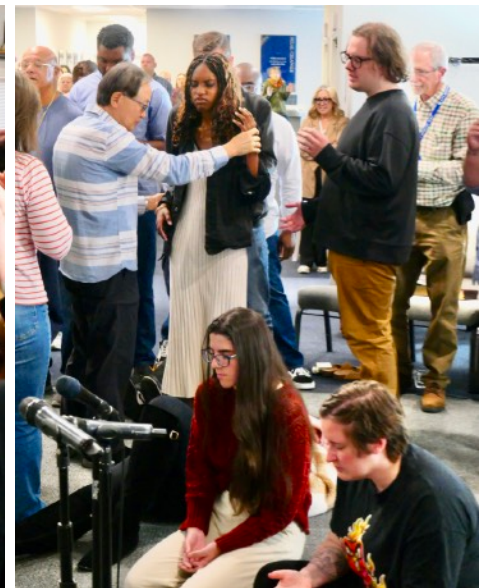
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Let us render Thanksgiving unto the Lord, the Creator of your life for His glory!

1. ***God knew you before He formed you in your mother's womb*** (Jeremiah 1:5): God has the blue print of your creation mandate and He will fulfill it for His own good pleasure. Therefore, you are never a mistake or an accident into this world regardless of your circumstances when you were born into this world. Jesus Christ is the Alpha and the Omega. 2. ***Give thanks to the Lord for He is good.
