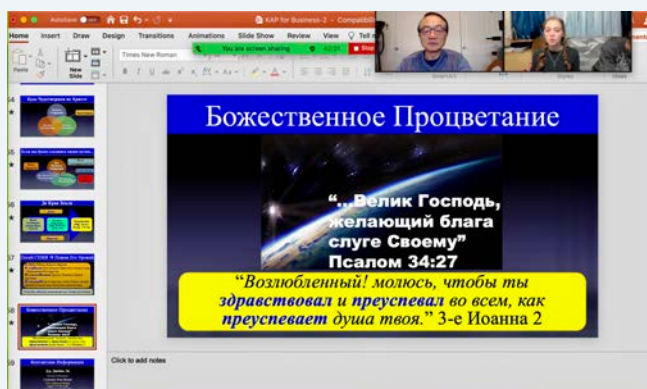

## Supporting the Children's Home Project and Conducting GHN Trainings



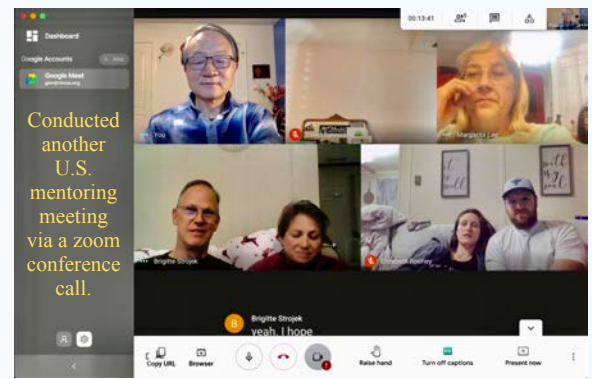

## Started a New GHN Training with American Friends in Virginia Beach



It was my great joy to minister to our friends in Virginia Beach with a GHN foundational course “How to walk in God’s kingdom authority and power!” at a friend’s home. 1 Cor. 4:20 declares, “*For the Kingdom of God is not in word but in power.*” Jesus Christ called His 12 apostles in Luke 6:12-13. Then he took them around and demonstrated how to move in God’s kingdom authority and power for three chapters by preaching the gospel of the kingdom and healing every sickness, every disease among the people, and casting out demonic spirits. The following are the records of how Jesus Christ demonstrated the kingdom authority and power to His 12 apostles from Luke 6:20 to Luke 8:56: Jesus taught “*Be Attitudes*” in Luke 6:20-45; He taught about building the foundation on the rock in Luke 6:46-49; He healed a Centurion’s servant in Luke 7:1-10; He raised the son of a widow of Nain in Luke 7:11-17; Jesus gave His answer to the messengers of John the Baptist in Luke 7:22, “*Go and tell John the things you have seen and heard: that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them. And blessed is he who is not offended because of Me.*”; He forgave a sinful woman in Luke 7:36-50; He explained the parable of the sower in Luke 8:4-15; Jesus caused the wind and the wave to obey His command in Luke 8:22-25; He healed a demon-possessed man in Luke 8:26-39; He resurrected a dead young girl and healed a woman with a issue of blood for 12 years in Luke 8:40-56. After training the apostles for a short time in three chapters, Jesus called His twelve disciples together and gave them **power and authority over all demons, and to cure diseases. He sent them to preach the kingdom of God and to heal the sick (Luke 9:1-2).** Amazingly, we read in Luke 9:6, “*So they departed and went through the towns, preaching the gospel and healing everywhere.*” As the apostles received the authority and power from Jesus Christ, they were able to perform the same miracles that He did in Luke 6:20 to 8:56. These events occurred before the cross, the resurrection of Christ, and the day of Pentecost. If it was the will of Christ before the cross for His apostles to also demonstrate the authority and power of the kingdom of God, then how much more for believers in Christ who are living after the cross, resurrection and the day of Pentecost to demonstrate His kingdom authority and power to destroy the works of the devil in our own Jerusalem to the ends of the earth!!! We are not just called to attend a church, but need to be the church for His glory!!!

By the grace of God, Margarita and I were able to accomplish what He had appointed us to do with trials and sufferings in January. Margarita and I got COVID and we had to be quarantined for 14 days and fought off the deadly virus claiming His promises in Isaiah 41:10. During this month, Margarita lost her oldest sister-in-law due to COVID in Colombia. We were very sad and tried to comfort Margarita’s brother, Jay who is 80 years old and had 52nd wedding anniversary last year. Jay and Charito were always so nice to us and we will dearly miss her. We also pray for all those people who have lost their loved ones through COVID this year. We truly have one life to live and Margarita and I will do our very best to glorify the Lord Jesus Christ for the rest of our short lives through River of Life Ministries and Door of Hope Foundation.
